HARLAN — Gaylin Duane (Red) Sisson, son of George and Myrtle Fritz Sisson was born May 4, 1930 in Harlan. He died Mar. 12, 1977 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan, at age 46 years, 10 months and eight days. Red was raised and educated in Harlan and graduated from the Harlan high school in 1950. He had worked with the Western Engineering Co. of Harlan doing road construction for 13 years. On Oct. 16, 1971 he married Marilyn Reznicek at Franklin, Nebr., where they resided before coming to Harlan three years ago.

Mr Sisson was preceded in death by his father - George in 1973.
