## Andrew Christian Sondergaard, 83

Andrew Christian Sondergaard, son of Ole and Maren Nelson Sondergaard wa born April 21, 1900 in Vejby, Denmark. He was baptized and confirmed in the Stat. Lutheran church, attended school and grew to adulthood in Denmark where he also was an apprentice in a grocery store.

He came to America about 1920 and started working for Nels Jorgensen. He late worked on the road crew, dynamiting, as they were paving Highway 64. He also wor

ed on other farms in the area until his marriage.

When he had established himself on a farm, he sent for Rigmor Petersen to con to America. They were married at the Lutheran Parsonage in Harlan on Feb. 3, 19. One son was born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed south of Harlan Lincoln twp. In 1939 they moved to a farm southeast of Corley, in Fairview twp. whi was their home until they retired and moved to Harlan in 1970. They were privileg to celebrated their golden wedding anniversary on Feb. 3, 1975. They were belongtime members of the Immanuel Lutheran church in Harlan.

Before her death on Feb. 7, 1975, they had planned to retire to Fla. In keeping we that plan, he moved to Port Richey, Fla. in Oct. of 1975. This was his home until retuing to Harlan in April of 1982 and making his home with his daughter-in-law, Marke Sondergaard. He then purchased his own home but because of ill health, becameresident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan in Jan. of 1983. He died Saturd June 25, 1983 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at the age of 83 years, 2 mon and 4 days.

In addition to his parents, his wife and his son, Hoffman, he was preceded in deby seven brothers, Tinus, Martin, Niels, Jens Christian, Jens, Thorvold and Per Sondergaard; three sisters - Johanna, Damgar and Otilla Jorgensen.
