

Frank P. Stinn, 78

Portsmouth — Frank Peter Stinn, son of Casper and Agnes Nowatzke Stinn, was born Aug. 16, 1903 in Earling. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Joseph's Catholic church and attended St. Joseph's Catholic school, both in Earling. He grew to adulthood in Earling and then worked on several farms in the Portsmouth area. After he retired in 1971, he made his home in Portsmouth.
