## Fred J. Stock, 68

KIRKMAN — Frederick John Stock, son of Eskerin and Clara Miller Stock, was born on a farm in Hazel Dell twp. in Pottawattamie county, on Dec. 8, 1908. He died at his home at RFD 1, Kirkman on June 14, 1977, at age 68 years, 6 months and 6 days. He attended school in Crescent and grew to adulthood on his parent's farm. On Dec. 1, 1936, he married Thelma Dahlof in Long Beach, Calif. Four children were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Stock farmed near Crescent, until 1946. At that time they moved to their parent farm in Douglas twp. in Shelby county. They retired from farming in 1972 and built their present home at rural Kirkman.
