

Mildred M. Struve, 62

Sutherland, Ia. — Mildred Maxine Struve, daughter of Raymond and Mable Axland Young, was born near Irwin in Shelby county on March 28, 1917. She graduated from Irwin high school and attended Iowa State Teachers College at Cedar Falls.

She married Irvin Struve on June 28, 1941 in Plattsmouth, Nebr. After WWII they made their home on a farm near Sutherland. She was a member of the United Methodist church in Sutherland and the United Methodist Women's Society. She was also a member of the American Legion Auxiliary and the Order of Eastern Star. She died at the Sioux Valley hospital in Cherokee on Sunday, July 8, 1979 at age 62 years.

She was preceded in death by her father. Survivors include her husband; three daughters - Judith (James) Carter of Laredo, Texas, Rebecca (Stephen) Hook of Muncie, Ind., Connie (Donald) Brown of Amarillo, Texas; one son - Craig Struve of Calumet, seven grandchildren; her mother - Mrs Mable Young of Irwin; two brothers - Jack and Donald of Irwin; two sisters - Mrs Fred (Lela) Hanson of Harlan and Mrs Donald (Charlotte) Doonan of Elk Horn and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the United Methodist church in Sutherland on Tuesday, July 10, 1979, with Rev. James Nicholson, officiating.
