

PASTOR STUB DIED IN  
NOVEMBER

1975

A January edition of the Kirke og Folk magazine carried the following new item:

The Rev. Chresten Andersen Stub died Nov. 23 in the Ebenezer Home at Minneapolis and was buried at Fredsville, Ia. Nov. 26. He was 83 years old and was survived by a daughter Helen, of Minneapolis, a son, Holger of Philadelphia, a brother and 2 grandchildren.

He was born at Elk Horn, Ia. and went to school at the local folk school and Saerslev Folk School in Denmark. His main education was obtained at the Univ. of Minn. in 3 rounds. He was a teacher at Ashland Folk School, twice at Dana College and twice at Grand View, the latter 1915-17 and 1924-27. He was also a newspaper man, editing 'Ungdom', 1923-30, 'Det Danske Ugeblad,' Minneapolis, 1918 and 1927-30 and 'Lutheran Tidings' 1933-40.

He married Anna Juhl in 1921 and in 1932 he was ordained, serving pastorates at Ringsted, Ia., 1932-38, Greenville, Mich. 1938-50 and Fredsville, Ia., 1950 thru 1960.
