## Bruce Syndergaard, 14

NEOLA — Bruce Syndergaard, 14-year-old son of the Donald Syndergaards of Neola, was killed Saturday afternoon when the bicycle he was riding was struck by a van.

According to witnesses, Syndergaard and Chad Chollett, 14, son of the Kenneth Cholletts of Underwood, were riding their bikes south along Highway 191 about a mile south of Weston when a van driven by Jerome Christiansen, Council Bluffs,

struck them.

Chollett died Sun., Jan. 25 at Jennie Edmundson hospital after suffering head and internal injuries. Syndergaard was pronounced dead on arrival at the hospital.

Funeral services for the Syndergaard youth were held this week at Meyer Funeral Home in Council Bluffs. Survivors include his parents; a brother, Bradley of Manchester; sisters, Brenda D. Syndergaard, Glenwood, and Beth R. Syndergaard, at home; grandfather, Ed Syndergaard

of Alta; grandnother, Theone Frederickson of Owen, Wis.; a niece and nephew; aunts, uncles and cousins.

The Syndergaard family moved to Neola from Manchester in 1977.
