

# Henry Ullrich, 82

Persia — Henry Ullrich, son of Joseph and Josepha Ullrich was born Jan. 6, 1897 in Klein Steibnitz, Czechoslovakia. He came to the U.S. in 1921 with Fred Zarestky, his sponsor and employer. He was a member of the Persia United Methodist church. He was employed on various farms in the Persia and Neola area. In 1933, he started farming for himself. He purchased a cafe in Persia and operated it for 17 years. In 1959, he purchased a farm which he operated until 1978 when he retired and moved to Persia. In 1935, he married Viola Seeley Miller.

He died Wednesday, June 13, 1979, in Myrtue Memorial hospital at age 82 years, 5 months and 7 days.

He was preceded in death by one daughter, Judith of Persia, his parents and two brothers all of Czechoslovakia. Survivors include his wife, Viola; two sons, Richard of Anchorage, Alaska and Arlen of Logan; seven grandchildren; one great grandson, nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Saturday, June 16, 1979 at the Persia United Methodist church with Rev. Donald McQuin and Rev. Beryl Hokel, officiating.
