Neola man dies from crash injuries

A 20-year-old Neola man died Saturday of injuries suffered when his car rolled into a ditch south of Persia.

Norman J. Wellman, of Route 2, Neola, was thrown from the car when it rolled into a ditch about two miles south of Persia on Highway 191.

The Iowa Highway Patrol said Wellman lost control of his car on a curve early Saturday. He died later at a Council Bluffs hospital.

Wellman was a 1984 graduate of Tri-Center High School and had attended Iowa University for a year. He was enrolled this year at Iowa Western Community College. He was employed by Barrier Belcon, Inc., and was a member of St. Patrick's Church in Neola. While in high school, he had been a member of the Future Farmers of America and the National Honor Society.

Survivors include his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph R. Wellman; a sister, Joan; three brothers, Paul, Alan and Raymond; paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Joe H. Wellman, all of Neola; and maternal grandparents Mr. and Mrs. Tony Bruck of Earling.
