

Annie Wiges, 92

Kimballton — Annie Wiges, daughter of Nels and Karen Rattenberg Mortensen, was born Oct. 13, 1887 in Gray. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church. She married Chris Wiges at the Bethany Lutheran church on Dec. 29, 1909. They lived in Audubon county and moved to Elk Horn in 1943. On June 30, 1975 she moved to the Salem Homes, Elk Horn, where she died Monday, May 26, 1980 at age 92 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Chris in 1966 and one son, Leonard in 1978. Survivors include a daughter, Alice Mortensen of Elk Horn, two sons, Earl Wiges and Don Wiges of Elk Horn, nine grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren and other relatives.
