WANDA JEAN WIGES, 44

Wanda Jean Wiges, daughter of John Lange and Irma Bramer, was born Aug. 28, 1930 in Shelby county. She was baptized and confirmed in the Elk Horn Lutheran church and attended Elk Horn high school. On April 27, 1946 she married Kenneth Andersen and to this union four children were born. Kenneth died on March 18, 1961. Wanda married Don Wiges on August 30, 1964 in Atlantic. During her married life she lived on several farms in Shelby county and much of her time has been devoted to her Sno Peke Dog Kennels. Currently she was in the grocery business in Elk Horn with her father John. Wanda died Wednesday, May 22, 1974 at Methodist hospital in Omaha, Nebr., at age 44 years.

She was preceded in death by her husband Kenneth Andersen and her mother, Irma Lange in 1955. Survivors include her husband Don, three daughters - Sherrie, (Mrs Jim Davis) of Altoona, Donna (Mrs Bruce Lange) of Wayne, Nebr., Keith and Joyce Andersen at home, her father John Lange and stepmother Erna of Elk Horn, one brother Gail Lange of
