

## Rev. Aloysius Wilwerding, 86

OMAHA — Concelebrated Mass of the Resurrection for S.J., Rev. Aloysius J. Wilwerding, a native of the Earling area, was held Wednesday morning at St. John's Church here. Interment was in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

The Rev. Wilwerding, a Jesuit priest, had resided at Creighton University. Memorial Mass was held Tuesday evening, also at St. John's Church in Omaha.

Survivors include one brother, Peter of Earling; and two sisters, Sr. Dorothy Ann, OSF, and Sr. Maureen, OSF, both of Dubuque, Ia.

Father Wilwerding entered the Jesuit order at Florissant, Mo., in 1917, and was ordained in St. Louis on June 27, 1928. He attended St. Louis University, St. Mary's College, St. Mary's Kan., and St. Stanislaus Seminary, Cleveland, Ohio.
