Irwin — Efa May Yost, daughter of Ed and Addie Stephens, was born in Irwin on July 11, 1900, where she resided most of her life until Oct. of 1976 when she took up residence in the Manning Plaza. She was graduated from the Irwin public school and took normal training at State Teacher's College, Cedar Falls, later teaching in the rural schools of Shelby county. On Nov. 17, 1919 she married Lowell Yost. This union was blessed with two sons. She was a member of the Irwin Church of Christ and the American Legion Auxiliary. She died Monday, March 27, 1978 at the Manning hospital at age 77 years.
