Dan Dowling, 87, Monterey, Calif., a former editorial cartoonist for the Omaha World-Herald and former Harlan resident, died last Tuesday in California.

Dowling was born in O-Neill, Neb. and spent his childhood in Harlan. He was a 1924 graduate of Harlan High School. The H.P. Dowling family owned Shelby County State Bank in the 1930s and 1940s.
