## Harold F. Trafton, M.D., 78

CO. BLUFFS - Harold F. Trafton, M.D., son of Dr. G.M. and Lillian Wiss Trafton, was born Nov. 7, 1917 in Chrisman, IL. He moved with his family to Paris, IL where he graduated from Paris High School. He then attended and graduated form the University of Illinois School of Arts and Sciences. After graduation he attended and was awarded a medical degree from the University of Illinois Medical School in

1941, serving his residency at City Hospital in St. Louis, MO.

Dr. Trafton married Bertha M. Beetham of Spooner, W in St. Louis, MO Feb. 2, 1942. They had five children. He joined the U.S. Army Air Corps and served overseas during WW II, attaining the rank of Captain and becoming a flight surgeon. After the war, he returned to St. Louis to complete his residency. He was a Board Certified Surgeon and member of the American College of Surgeons and the International College of Surgeons. He was an Associate Professor at Creighton University training medical students in the Medical School's residency program. Dr. Trafton served as president of the Pottawattamie County Medical Society and lowa Academy of Surgery. He served on the board of lowa Blue Cross, Blue Shield and belonged to the Flying Physicians and the Flying Fools. He was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church. He and Bee have continued to make Co. Bluffs their home since his retirement in Oct. of 1991. He died at his home June 1, 1996 following a long illness.

He was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife, Bee; daughter, Pat Jones of Harlan; daughter, Mary Kay (Sal) Carta of Omaha; daughter, Bette (Randy) Schmidt of Co.
