Comes now Thomas Barkley, the duly appointed and legally qualified administrator in the above and foregoing estate and represents to the Court that said estate is perfectly solvent and that the only heir-at-law of said estate is the deceased mother, Priscilla Barkley; that the said heir together with the brothers and sisters of the deceased are desirous that a suitable and proper monument be placed at the grave of the deceased; that the expense thereof to be charged to the said estate herein is Three Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$375.00); that said sum is a suitable amount to pay for said monument and will leave the estate perfectly solvent to pay all debts filed and allowed against said estate.

WHEREFORE, The administrator herein, Thomas Barkley asks an order from this Court authorizing, empowering and directing him to place a suitable monument at the grave of the deceased and charge same to the estate herein.
