The following is taken from her memorial stone in Pleasant Ridge Cemetery:

Step softly, a dream lies buried here: Harrison E. Cass, a diligent Des Moines youth impressed with the magnificence of southern California, moved there for pre-law college study. The advent of WWII dictated he return to the University of Iowa for a year before returning to the "west". There he met the radiant Virginia HAROVER, a popular "Hawkeye beauty" honor student from Cedar Rapids who was born in Boulder, Colorado. Early on they learned benefits came from working together. A strong, devoted, loving partnership developed. On November 27, 1943 they were married at Louisville, Kentucky. By 1955, their thriving partnership involved adventurous, professional and entrepreneurial situations across the country, and a growing family. They needed a permanent home in the center of the country. They returned to Iowa, remodeled and moved to the nearby, historic "Stedebharan Farm" where they raised their four children, namely: Ann Hathaway born March 29, 1945 at Ft. Knox, Kentucky; Harrison E., Jr. born August 9, 1948 at Trenton, Michigan; Deborah Ann born September 13, 1950 at Trenton, Michigan; and Stephen Harover born April 15, 1954 at Des Moines, Iowa.
