### **Obituary**

Mrs. George Clarke, whose maiden name was Bessie Jane Kirk, daughter of Hester and James Kirk, was born January 18, 1866, in what is now known as Highland Park in north Des Moines.

A few years later she moved with her parents to a farm east of Grimes, remaining there until her marriage to George Clarke of Norwalk, January 28, 1891. Mr. Clarke preceded her in death May 8, 1942.

After living north of Norwalk for three years they moved southwest of Norwalk where she lived until her death January 7, 1944, at the age of 77 years, 11 months, and 20 days.

She is survived by five children: George, Paul and Henry of Norwalk, Joe of Milwaukee, Wisconsin and Kathryn Van Pelt of Leon; one sister, Mrs. Nettie Seibert of Minburn; 10 grandchildren; nephews; and nieces.

She joined the Presbyterian church of Grimes when a young girl. She was a devoted mother to her children. She had an unselfish nature and was always willing to help others.

Kirk, James – Farmer, section 4, P. O. Des Moines. Was born in Ohio, January 2, 1830, and was there raised. While young he learned the cooper's trade, and followed it until the spring of 1858, when he came to this county. He has lived here since, following farming, and is now the owner of one hundred and sixty acres of land. His residence is surrounded by fine shade trees, and is well located. He was married in Ohio, September 22, 1861, to Miss Hester J. Griffith. They have had eleven children, of whom seven are living: William F., Henry B., Mary, James, Charles F., Jennette and Bessie. Four are deceased: Edgar, and three infants.
