Mrs. Drake of nearOrilliadied very suddenly last Thursday night. She retired well and hearty and before morning she was a corpse.

We are sorry to relate the death of Mrs. Drake, of Orilla, who went to bed in her usual health Friday night and was found dead the next morning, only being sick about twenty minutes. The funeral took place from her home Monday at 10 a.m.

[The Indianola Herald, Thursday, April 11, 1895, Page 4, Column 3] Cumming News Item

Friday morning occurred the death of Mrs. Drake living northeast of Orillia. She spoke to her husband and said she was sick. He arose immediately to go for aid, but she passed away without speaking again. She was apparently as well as usual on retiring the evening before. She leaves an aged husband and six grown children: the eldest son William arrived from Colorado Saturday night, so that all her children were present at the funeral, which took place Monday morning. Rev. A. A. Thompson conducted the services after which she was buried at Pleasant Ridge.
