### Additional Misc.

Robert Johnson Etherington was born December 25, 1850 at Pella, Marion Co., Iowa and died April 30, 1914 in Oakesdale, Whitman Co., Washington. He was buried in the Oakesdale Cemetery.

Their son William was born January 4, 1875 in Marion Co. and died April 25, 1951. He died at Rapidan, Blue Earth Co., Minnesota and is buried at Algona, Kossuth Co., Iowa in the East Lawn Cemetery. He married Matilda Ines and they had 7 children.
