#### Obituary

[Indianola Herald, Thursday, April 5, 1934]

Ruth Kirts, 17, of Cumming, committed suicide Monday evening at 11:30, by drinking carbolic acid. She died, despite the efforts of a doctor who was called immediately, at 12 o'clock.

Coroner C. H. Mitchell was called and, after questioning members of the girl's family, and her friend, Merle Tovrea, pronounced the death a plain case of suicide and called no inquest.

Miss Kirts and Tovrea had been in each other's company for over a year. Tovrea, according to his answers to Mitchell's questioning, had started to break up the friendship and had been seen with other girls. Miss Kirts had threatened several times to commit suicide, but neither Tovrea nor another who heard her threat, took it seriously.

A dance at Cumming Monday evening attracted both, and Miss Kirts asked Tovrea to take her to the home of her brother-in-law, Russell Duffy. He did, and they talked on the front porch. Being disturbed by cars pulling up in front, they went to the kitchen. Shortly after Tovrea bid the girl good-bye. As he was leaving he saw her raise a bottle to her lips and heard her scream for Duffy. Tovrea ran for a doctor, who was unable to save the girl's life.

Ruth Kirts is survived by her mother.
