

Funeral services for Mrs. Cora J. Miller, 62, wife of William Ward Miller and a resident of WarrenCounty more than 43 years, were at 2 p.m. Thursday at the farm house near Cumming, Iowa.

The Rev. Harry S. Longley, pastor of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, assisted in the service. Dunn's Funeral Home was in charge. Burial was in the Orillia, Iowa cemetery.

Mrs. Miller died at Mercy hospital Sunday morning after a severe illness. She had lived on the Miller farm north of Cumming 41 years.

Surviving are her husband, four sons and three daughters. The sons are: Frank W. and Arthur M. of Cumming, Irvine O. of Orillia, and Clarence W. of Des Moines. The daughters are: Mrs. V. W. Berney of Des Moines, Mrs. E. J. Collins and Mrs. M. P. Laughlin of Cumming. A sister and three brothers also survive.
