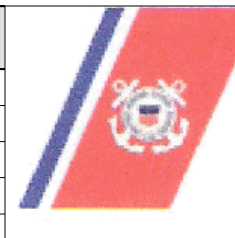

 He was born Sept. 30, 1912 in Chickasaw County, Iowa, a son of Edward and Mary Anderson Attleson, and was educated in Iowa schools.
 Mr. Attleson served in the U.S. Coast Guard during World War II. He was featured on military posters as "America's Typical Sailor," according to the family.
 He farmed in Iowa, then was employed by the former Saco-Lowell Shops, the Maine Department of Transportation for over 25 years

A son, Henry, died in 1971.
