Funeral services will be Thursday, April 23. at Trinity Lutheran Church in New Hampton, with the pastor Rev. Bernard Oebser officiating. Edith Kalthoff will be organist and Ruth Ann Upham soloist. Gertrude Sarah Attleson was born Jan 11, 1900, in Chickasaw County, the daughter of Thomas and Synneva (Vikdal) Attleson. She was baptized and confirmed at Crane Creek Lutheran Church. She at-tended a rural school in Jacksonville Township and high school at Forest City.

Prior to her illness she did domestic work in New Hampton and was organist at Crane Creek Lutheran Church and later at the former St. Olaf Lutheran Church in New Hampton for many years. She was a member of Trinity Church at the time of her death.
