Hans Sigurd Attleson, 73, of New Hampton. died at 12:10 a.m. Wednesday at Saint Joseph Community Hospital, where he had been a patient since Friday after suffering a theart attack. -

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Saturday at Trinity Lutheran Church wIth the Rev. John Rohde officiating.

Burrial will be at Crane Creek Cemetery with full military rites,Perry Conway -Funeral Services has charge of arrangements. He was born October 29, 1894 in Jacksonville Township, the son of Thomas and Synneve Vikdal Attleson and at-tended area schools.

Mr. Attleson was a World War I veteran, having served overseas in the 351st Infantry. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church and the American Legion Fae Stine Post 38.

A retired farmer, Mr. At-tleson was also employed as a Post Office custodian for several years.

Survivors include three brothers, E. J. (Pete) Attleson, Selmar Attleson and Thomas Attleson all of New Hampton: two sisters, Gertrude Attleson of New Hampton and Sigrid Attleson of Waterloo. He was preceded in death by his parents. six brothers, Sjur, Torkel, Attley, Gustav, Ben and Sjur and a sister, Lucille Attleson.
