<p>As a child, Johannes lived with his sister Mrs. H.P. Ronnie. In January 1920, his widowed mother, Kari age 65, and her sisters Jennie and Gertrude were living with him. John was Secretary of the Crane Creek Lutheran Church. He served on the Jacksonville Township School board, and as Director of the Jerico Telephone Company. John and Irene were married in the Crane Creek Parsonage. In the spring of 1946, John was badly burned.</p>

<p>OBITUARY: Irene Attleson, 87, died Thursday, May 28 at Saint Joseph Community Hospital. Funeral services were held Monday, June 1 at 11 a.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church with Rev. Bernard Oebser officiating. Edith Kolthoff was organist and accompanied those in attendance as they sang "Who Is This Host Arrayed In White" and "Lord Take My Hand and Lead Me." Interment was in Crane Creek Cemetery, rural lawler, with John, David and Edward Gordon, James Wignall, Keith and Steve Cutsforth as pall bearers. Irene B. Gordon was born August 26, 1899 in Chickasaw County, the daughter of John A. and Ingeborg (Thronson) Gordon. She was baptized and confirmed at Crane Creek Lutheran Church and was united in marriage to John J. Attleson on October 14, 1943. at the Crane Creek Church. She and her husband resided in New Hampton after their marriage. At the time of her death, Irene was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in New Hampton.</p> <p>She was preceded in death by her husband. who died in 1946: a son Gordon, who died in 1960; four brothers Alfred, Edward, Clarence and John Gordon; one sister, Tilda Annett; a half brother, Andrew Gordon: and a half sister Carrie Dahlen. She is survived by numerous nieces and nephews. Conway Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.</p>
