OBITUARY: L. Attleson Dies Suddenly Sunday A.M. -

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at Trinity Lutheran Church for Lucille Attleson, 63, who died Sunday, Sept. 17. Miss Attleson was stricken with an apparent heart attack at Trinity Lutheran Church in Waterloo.
