Thos. Attleson of Jerico passed away Sunday afternoon, wife and twelve children survive.-

A cloud of sadness and sorrow has been hovering over this community the past week and many'a home has been darkened and grief-stricken by the loss of a loved one. A splendid character and a faithful worker is an asset to every community and to every home, and when the head of a family who posses the many good traits and wise guidance credited to Thos. Attleson who has passed on to the heavenly rest, the loss is extremely great.

Mr. Attleson suffered a stroke of paralysis about thlrteen months ago and altho his condition has been quite poorly, his rugged constitution held up for some time.

He died Sunday afternoon, August 23, 1925, at 2 Oclock at hIs farm home near Jerlco. In fact a relief to him by the pitiful angel of the last long sleep.

The funeral will take place Wednesday afternoon, August 26th, at 1:00 at the home, and 2:00 o'clock at the Crane Creek church, Rev. Erickson will officiate. The casket will be carried by six of his sons. Burial will take place in the parish cemetery.

Attleson was a man of sur-passing qualities of mind and judg-ment, active and industrious, He was a skillful guide in an ideal home and how he loved his home and his dear ones was manifested in so many ways.
