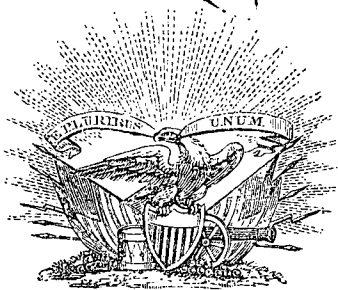

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th,

1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 76331. for 40. acres,

issued in favor of *Mary Parker, widow of Martin Parker Private in Captain Clark's Company, New York Militia War of 1812,*

the Tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said
