

PIONEER RESIDENT DIES WEDNESDAY, SERVICES SATURDAY.

Services were held at the Lockwood - Jongewaard Funeral Home here Saturday for Edith Regenberg, who died at Merrill Pioneer Community Hospital here Wednesday. Miss Regenberg was a long time resident of Rock Rapids. She had been seriously ill since Sunday.

The Rev. Everett Major, pastor of the Methodist Church, officiated at the services which were held at the funeral home chapel. Mrs. Ella Rasmussen was at the organ and accompanied Mrs. Craig Vinson who sang two numbers, "My God and I" and The Old Rugged Cross".

Edith Regenberg was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Regenberg. She was born in Dale Township, near Matlock, on May 27, 1882. After living on the farm as a child and young woman, she came to Rock Rapids with her family in 1908. She has lived here since, at the family home on West First Avenue.

Surviving are a brother, Frank, and a sister, Mattie Uden. Also surviving are a niece and two nephews. Preceding her in death were her parents, two half brothers, one brother and two sisters.

Miss Regenberg had been a member of the Rebekah Lodge here for almost 50 years.
