KIMBALLTON - Bruce Alan Elmquist, son of Arlo and Alice Olsen Elmquist. was born June 27, 1947, in Carroll. From February of 2005 until March of 2007, he was employed by Riekes Distributing, Inc. in Omaha, NE. He was in the warehouse and shipping department. He then devoted himself to farming as long as his health allowed him. He was a member of Bethany Lutheran Church northeast of Kimballton and was the President of the Church Council. He repaired and restored antique tractors and farm equipment. He died July 14, 2007, at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, NE at age 60 years and 17 days.
