HARLAN – Mildred Jane England, daughter of James D. and Mary (Robertson) Shaw, was born July 12, 1917 in Warsaw, MO. She had been a member of Bethel Baptist Church in Harlan, since 1989. She was introduced to Wayne Valentine England by her brother Donald in Red Oak, then later moved to California.

Mildred played the harmonica and often played for church programs. In June 1985, Mildred and Wayne celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. She died May 26, 2007, at Myrtue Medical Center at age eighty-nine years, ten months, and fourteen days.
