ELK HORN — Dorothy Janene Sanborn, daughter of Laverne E. and Izroa Larsen Durham Kline, was born May 22, 1937, in Omaha, NE. She was raised on a chicken farm. She attended school at Van Nuys High School and then later attended St. Olaf College in Minnesota.

Dorothy married Larry Edgington in 1958 in Van Nuys, CA and to this union two daughters were born, Chris-Ellen and Tauni. She was later married to Alfred Sanborn at a chapel in the hills in California. To this union, one son was born, Allen. She was employed as a stockbroker clerk during her residency in California. In 1987, Dottie moved to Elk Horn to be close to her family. In 1989, she retired and began to work part-time at the Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn in the dietary department. Dorothy died June 28, 2005, at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics in Iowa City at age 68 years, one month and six days.
