AVOCA — Jeffery Otto Schueman, the son of James O. and Phyllis Myers Schueman, was born March 13, 1958, in Harlan, and was one of three children in the family. He attended school in Avoca and graduated with the class of 1976. During high school he worked for Harry Wendt doing painting. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca.

Jeff married Dianne Emken on July 16, 1988, at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca.
