HARLAN — Steven Michael Schuemann, son of Harry "Mo" and Carol Ann (Knouse) Schuemann, was born on April 26, 1949 in Harlan. He attended school in Newton, and received his GED in 1991. After school, Steve began working at Oakland Beef in Oakland. He continued to work in Oakland until 1977 when he became the owner of Shade Tree Salvage Yard in Harlan where he worked until his retirement in 1998.

February 14, 2004, Steve was united in marriage to Patrice C. Young in Harlan. After their wedding, the couple made their home in Harlan. Steve died on Thursday, March 12, 2009, at Myrtue Medical Center in Harlan, having attained the age of fifty-nine years, ten months, and fourteen days.
