

Glenn Schwarte, 57

LITTLETON, CO — Glenn Isadore Schwarte, was born Feb. 17, 1949, in Earling, the son of Lavina (Leinen) and Wilfred Schwarte. He received his education at St. Joseph's Catholic School In Earling, and was a member of the graduating class of 1967. After graduation, he enlisted in the United States Army. Glenn served his country in Vietnam. He received his honorable discharge April 29, 1973.

Glenn married Carol Ann Mason July 19, 1975, in Mc-Cook, NE. After their marriage, the couple made their home in Denison. They were the parents of two children, Heather and Thomas. He worked in taxes and insurance. He was awarded



an ITT Award for outstanding performance and achievement in group sales. He was also awarded an ITT Award for the Distinction of Membership in the 1977 Executive Club. After a few years of residing in Denison, the family moved to Morrison, CO, and later to Littleton, CO. He died June 15, 2006, at his home at age 57.
