She also worked at The Evergreen Inn in Harlan and as a cook at Nub's Pub in Panama and the Westphalia Club House. After his retirement in 1998, Bob loved to keep busy in his hobby shop at the house. He could be found making three-wheel bikes and iron sculptures out of old farm machinery. Once Sally retired, she enjoyed quilting and spoiling her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and husband. The couple spent their winters in Texas but were always ready to come home to their family. Bob and Sally died on Wednesday, October 26, 2011 as the result of an automobile accident south of Harlan. Bob had attained the age of seventy-one years, two months, and twelve days. Sally had attained the age of sixty-eight years, nine months, and twenty-three days.
