

Carroll and Dora Scott

HARLAN - Carroll Jay Scott, son of Ernest and Olive (Sloan) Scott, was born Dec. 25, 1906, at Columbus, NE. He received his schooling in Nebraska. Carroll served in the U.S. Army during peace time and was stationed in the Phillipines. He worked for and retired from Wilson's Packing Company in Omaha, NE.

Sept. 7, 1932, he married Alice Ferguson and they resided in Omaha. Alice died March 4, 1972.

Dora Ida Scott, daughter of Theodore and Freda Torneten, was born Sept. 22, 1906, at the Torneten farm east of Co. Bluffs. She received her elementary schooling at the country school nearby and then attended Abraham Lincoln High School in Co. Bluffs.

Nov. 18, 1931, Dora married Dallas Arnold and they became the parents of five children. The couple farmed until 1942, and then moved to Co. Bluffs. After Dallas' death, Dora worked at the Jennie Edmundson nurses dorm for eight years.

Dora and Carroll were married June 29, 1974, at St. John's United Church of Christ in Co. Bluffs. They made their home in Omaha until 1986, when they moved to Harlan.

Dora became a resident of Little Flower Haven in Earling in 1994. It was there that she died July 22, 1997, at age 90 years and ten months. She was preceded in death by her husband, Dallas Arnold; her infant son, Orville Theodore Arnold, and her sisters, Edna Torneten, Lydia Graalfs and Hilda Meppen. She is survived by her children, Lois Wirth (Rusty) of Harlan; Wayne Arnold of Orting, WA; Arlyn Arnold (Mildred) of Co. Bluffs and Dean Arnold of Co. Bluffs; her sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Waters of Co. Bluffs; eight grandchildren; one foster grandchild and 16 great grandchildren and other relatives.

Carroll died July 23, 1997, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 90 years, six months and 28 days. He was preceded in death by his wife, Alice, and his sister, Anita Welis. He is survived by his stepchildren, step grandchildren, foster step grandchild, great step grandchildren and two nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held for Mr. and Mrs. Scott July 28, 1997, at Pauley Funeral Home with Rev. C.G. "Gary" Nienkamp officiating. Burial for Dora was in Walnut Hill Cemetery in Co. Bluffs. Burial for Carroll was in Hillcrest Cemetery in Omaha. Rev. Antipmy Portero-Paff was the committal service officiant.
