She worked there until her retirement in 2001. Mary loved to be in her garden, tending to her flowers, loved doing crafts, but mostly loved the time she was able to spend with her grandchildren. Mary died on Sunday, February 15, 2015 at the Little Flower Haven Nursing Home in Earling, having attained the age of eighty-one years, eight months, and twenty days.

Mary was preceded in death by her parents, husband James, and sister Marjory Jones. She is survived by her children: Debby and her husband Corey Campbell of Irwin, James Shelton, Jr. and his wife Dori of Carlisle, PA, and Pat Shelton and his wife Jennifer of Harlan; nine
