Randy had his own nickname, "Hiney", and also had a nickname for everyone he met. He enjoyed fishing and watching NASCAR racing, and especially loved cheering on his favorite football team, the Minnesota Vikings. Randall H. Stolz died on Wednesday, October 8, 2014, at Myrtue Medical Center in Harlan,

having reached the age of 63 years, 9 months, and 21 days. Randy was preceded in death by his parents and one granddaughter, Paige Schwarte. He is survived by four children, Gary Stolz. (special friend, Janice Christensen) of Earling, Becky (Jason) Finken of Harlan, Tina (Kelly) Schwarte of Earling, and Randy Stolz of Earling; six siblings, Twyla (Bob) McConnell of Defiance, Sid Stolz of Defiance, Deb (Ked) Frederick of Earling, Pam (Randy) Schwery of Earling, Russ (Jill) Stolz of Defiance, and Cheri Crawley (special friend, Bruce Christensen) of Harlan; seven grandchildren, Noa, Chase, Evan, and Kai Finken, and Parker, Pyper, and Paxton Schwarte; and other relatives and friends.
