

Ivy Sutton-White, 76

June 8, 1924 - April 23, 2001

OMAHA - Ivy Dylis Sutton-White was born in Manchester, England, June 8, 1924, daughter of Joe and Henretta French Bowler. She was one of seven children in her family. She worked as an attendant at a theatre in her hometown of Manchester. She was working as a waitress in a mess hall during the war when she met Ronnie Sutton.

Ivy married Ronald Sutton April 27, 1946, in Manchester. Later that year she came to the United States of America on the Queen Mary and settled in Avoca. They were the parents of four children, Harvey, Shirley, Bernice and Laurie. She worked as a nurses aide while raising her children and after they were on their own. In 1987, she moved to Washington State and remarried. She returned to Nebraska in 1992 after the death of her current husband in 1991. She has lived in Nebraska since 1992. Ivy died April 23, 2001, in Omaha, NE, at age 76 years, 10 months and 15 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her first husband, Ronnie Sutton of Avoca; and her second husband of Washington state; her three brothers and her three sisters. She is survived by her four children, Harvey Sutton (Brenda) of Omaha; Shirley (Mike) Williams of Omaha; Bernice (Gary) White of Bremerton, WA and Laurie (Laverne) McCann of Council Bluffs; her five grandchildren and her five great grandchildren; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
